

BELOW IS A LIST OF ACTIVITIES OF THE CLIMATE JUSTICE GROUP OF THE PAST YEAR'S:

- ✓ last summer Monica & Doug hosted a solar house party as part of MNIPL's push for participating in either residential or community solar garden program.
- ✓ in the fall negotiated a reduced garbage contract with our hauler and initiated organic recycling (using same company) program for the church community including all of our tenants
- ✓ early winter sent in an entry form highlighting our new organic recycling to the Interfaith Power & Light (national org) "cool congregation" contest, which although not successful, was still good to document our environmental activities.
- ✓ had a full table (12) of Judsonites attend the Feb fundraiser of MNIPL at the Science Museum
- ✓ received notice in late March that our application to the Mpls stormwater quality credit program was accepted for installing rain gardens that reduce our runoff into the city's storm sewer system. We will save nearly \$20/ month, and this is retroactively being applied to Sept of 2018 when the application was sent to the city.
- ✓ started working this winter with MNIPL & Sundial Energy on their NEW solar bulk buy program to put solar panels on congregations in the twin cities. Viewed webinars in Feb and March from them on the details of program, sent in preliminary materials to start the process, had representative from MNIPL attend a 2nd hour discussion at Judson in Feb to explain the solar bulk buy program and do Q & A, had follow up video conference with MNIPL & Sundial Energy and church council members on preliminary technical and financial specifics for Judson church. and will be presenting final details in May to the Church Council and Congregation for approval to move forward.
